


Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of exhibition eligibility.

Terms and Conditions

- 1 The selection of exhibitors is determined by the Organizing Committee. Applicants must ensure that all information provided in the application is accurate and may not be altered without prior approval from the Committee. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel participation if the exhibitor fails to comply with the stated conditions.
- 2 Upon approval, the Organizing Committee will issue an official confirmation letter and invoice via email. Exhibitors who receive the participation notice must follow the payment instructions accordingly.
- 3 Applicants must guarantee the authenticity of all submitted artworks. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel participation if the exhibitor does not adhere to the regulations.
- 4 Exhibition spaces may not be transferred or altered, and displaying or conducting transactions outside the assigned exhibition space is strictly prohibited. The Organizing Committee may cancel participation and decline future applications if the exhibitor violates these conditions.
- 5 Craft works and antiques are not permitted for display within the exhibition rooms.

Rules & Guidelines

- 1 Exhibitors must open their exhibition rooms by 11:50 AM on public viewing days. Any delay or reduction of exhibition hours is not permitted.
- 2 Artworks must be displayed only within the assigned exhibition room designated by the Organizing Committee. Personal items, flower stands, or artworks placed in public areas or corridors are strictly prohibited.
- 3 All exhibitors are required to obtain their own insurance covering artworks and equipment for the entire duration of the fair. Exhibitors bear full responsibility for any damage, loss, theft, fire, water damage, or incidents during transportation. The Organizing Committee and the hotel assume no liability for damage to artworks or equipment caused by exhibitors, their staff, other exhibitors, or visitors. Exhibitors must comply with all safety regulations.
- 4 During installation, exhibition, and dismantling periods, exhibitors and their staff must wear an Exhibitor Pass or an Installation/Dismantling Pass when entering the venue. All installation and dismantling must be completed within the timeframe designated by the Organizing Committee.
- 5 For security reasons, exhibitors must complete an Artwork Removal Request Form before taking any artwork out of the exhibition room. After review and approval at the service counter, removal will be permitted.
- 6 During installation and dismantling, all artwork transportation must be done using the freight elevator. Exhibitors are responsible for any floor or property damage caused by negligence and must cover repair and compensation costs.
- 7 If any display obstructs visitor movement or poses safety concerns, the Organizing Committee may request adjustments or, if necessary, relocate the artwork at its discretion.

Exhibition Space Guidelines

- 1 Exhibitor staff must remain in the exhibition room during official operating hours and designated cleaning times, and must dismantle and clean the room in accordance with the Exhibitor Manual.
- 2 Exhibitors must install their exhibition rooms following the instructions outlined in the Exhibitor Manual. Drilling, nailing, or making holes in the walls is strictly prohibited. Wallpaper, furniture, and fixtures must not be damaged. Hotel staff will inspect the room during check-in and check-out. Any damage caused during the exhibition period must be fully compensated by the exhibitor, including repair costs and related expenses.
- 3 Hotel-owned items must not be removed from the room at any time during the exhibition. If such removal occurs, the hotel reserves the right to request immediate corrective action.
- 4 Commercial transactions and commercial advertising are not permitted within the exhibition area outside of official exhibition hours.
- 5 Smoking inside the exhibition room is strictly prohibited. Exhibitors may not bring hazardous or restricted materials into the exhibition room.
- 6 Exhibitors agree to comply with the hotel exhibition room and space usage regulations signed by the Organizer and Conrad Singapore Orchard. Any violation of these regulations may result in legal responsibility for the exhibitor.

Force Majeure

In the event of accidental incidents, pandemics, political or economic disruptions, governmental orders, or any circumstances beyond the control of the Organizing Committee, the Committee reserves the right to postpone the fair or shorten its duration. In such cases, exhibitors are not entitled to request refunds or compensation of any kind.

Image & Promotional Content Usage Guidelines

The organizer may use images of the exhibition space (hotel guest rooms), installation scenes, and portions of exhibited artworks for official promotional purposes, including websites, social media platforms, brochures, and other authorized channels. Copyright for all artworks remains with the exhibitor, and any usage beyond promotional purposes will require the exhibitor's prior approval.
